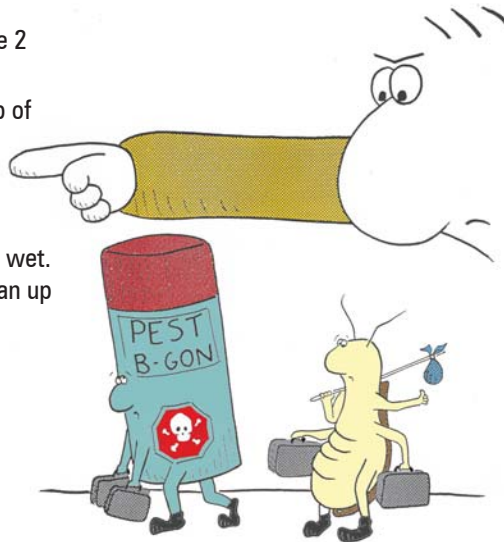

Directions:

1. Remove the lid of the provided "IPM Cleaner Solution" spray bottle.
2. Pour in liquid dish detergent to the 2 oz. line at bottom of bottle.
3. Add water to the 30 oz. line at top of bottle.
4. Replace lid and shake gently.
5. Clean up insects.

Sprayed surfaces may be slippery when wet. Never use "IPM Cleaner Solution" to clean up wasp, yellow jacket, or bee nests.
